I Never Thought About It Till I Saw It

Adopting randomly found online images as reference and using the panorama setting on his smartphone camera Morgan Buck weaves together a series of six paintings that speak of a psychology and unwonted deduction. Included in this exhibition are six new works that seek a narrative that is fictitious of an otherwise legitimate origin. Buck's considers this unorthodox use of the Internet to develop content (subsequently resulting in a printouts as a reference point) as a developing way of the removal of self from an initial step in the painting process, allowing a "disinterested self-expression", with the painting using airbrush on canvas completing a final imaginative illusion.

Morgan Buck lives and works in Portland, Oregon. He earned a BFA from the Pacific Northwest College of Art and a MFA from Oregon College of Art and Craft. Recent exhibitions include *Goggles Glazed Over*, Upfor Gallery, Portland Oregon and *Real Images of American History*, Kunstraum Ping Pong, Leipzig, Germany. Buck currently holds European representation with Lesluzep, an online gallery for contemporary art based in Zurich, Switzerland.
